## Stock Market Outlook for Monday, July 16, 2018

**HEADLINE:** Historically, the most volatile period for stocks is between the middle of July and the beginning of October.

### The Markets

Last week, the S&P 500 Index gained 1.50%, closing marginally above psychological resistance at 2800. Support at the 20-week moving average remains apparent. An inverse head-and-shoulders pattern can be implied by the price action over the six months. Momentum indicators are attempting to hold in bullish territory. For now, the market looks to be in good shape, but seasonal tendencies beyond the week ahead give reason for caution.
